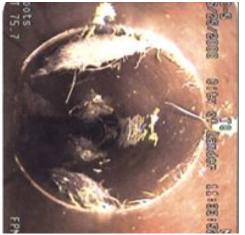
PRIORITIZING PROJECTS

THIS ENGINEERING DATA COMBINED WITH VIDEO FOOTAGE OF SEWERS AND THE KNOWN CONDITION OF WATER LINES ALLOWED THE CITY TO PRIORITIZE PROJECTS FOR THE 2020-2026 FUTURE PROJECTS.

THE CITY NOW PRIORITIZES PROJECTS WITH VARIOUS REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION METHODS THAT BEST FIT THE DATA AND THE NEIGHBORHOOD.

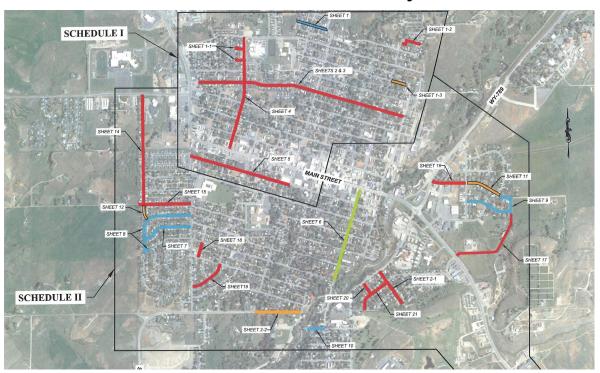

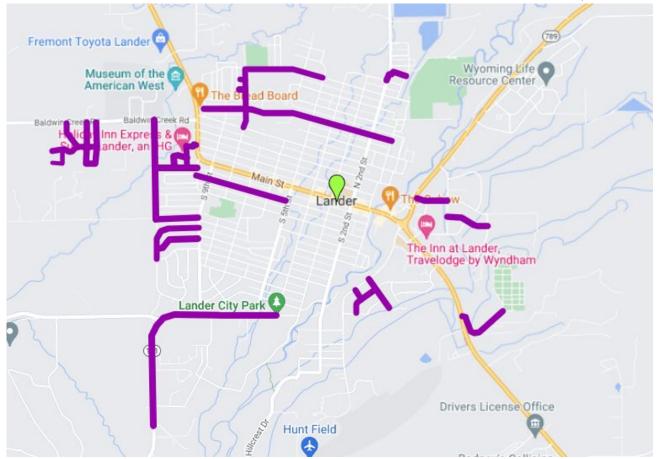

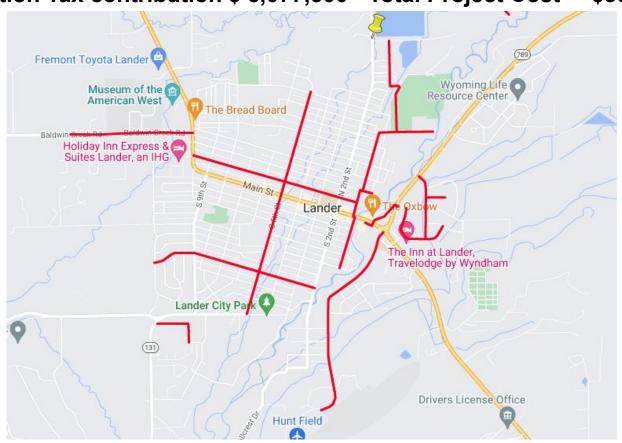
