

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed Bids for the construction of the City of Lander Infiltration Reduction Project – 4<sup>th</sup> Street/Hospital Run will be received by the City of Lander, at City Hall, 240 Lincoln Street, Lander, WY 82520 until 10:00 a.m. local time on **April 4, 2017**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. This project consists of:

Open cut replacement of approximately 1,145 lineal feet of sanitary sewer, replacement of 11 sanitary sewer manholes, cast in place pipe lining (CIPP) of 7,170 lineal feet of sanitary sewer main, sewer main point repairs, reconnection of service laterals, and in-place rehabilitation of 16 sanitary sewer manholes including reforming concrete benches and inverts and relining. Surface restoration will consist of approximately 2,300 SY of asphaltic pavement trench patching.

Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8am-5pm. Bid security in the form of a bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid must accompany each bid in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders. No Bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled time for the public opening of Bids. Successful bidder has 30 days to execute the contract once it is awarded.

Contract security (performance and payment bonds) in the amount equal to 100% of contract price will be required on this project per W.S. 15-1-113(d) and 16-6-112 and the General Conditions.

The Contractor shall meet substantial completion of all work within 60 calendar days of the Notice to Proceed and in no case later than October 20, 2017. Final completion of all work shall be reached within 15 calendar days of the substantial completion date and in no case later than November 4, 2017. Final payment will be withheld until final completion and acceptance of the Work as stipulated in the Agreement and all project closeout paperwork is completed.

The Contract shall be let to the responsible certified resident making the lowest bid, if the certified resident's bid is not more than five percent (5%) higher than that of the lowest responsible nonresident bidder and the resident bidder does not propose to subcontract more than thirty percent (30%) of the work to nonresident contractors. A resident for these purposes must be certified as a resident by the Wyoming Department of Workforce Services prior to bidding upon the Contract. See W.S. 16-6-101, et seq. A resident bidder shall submit a copy of its certificate of residency with bid.

Pursuant to W.S. 16-6-106, "preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to articles offered by the competitors outside of the state".

The procurement will be subject to the "Use of American Iron and Steel" requirements as contained in Section 436 of H.R. 3547, The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all proposals received, to waive informalities, to postpone the Notice of Award for a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days, and to accept the lowest responsive and responsible bid which is in the best interest of the Owner.

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
